Project Supplies You Will Need

1 Ball® Quart Regular Jar

1 Ball® Regular Band and Dome® Lid

Masking Tape
(2 inches wide)

1 (2-ounce) Bottle
Black Acrylic Craft Paint

1 (1-inch wide) Paint
Brush or Foam Brush

1 Sheet (9- x 12-inch)
Black Stiffened Felt

1 Sheet (9- x 12-inch)
Pink Stiffened Felt

1 Black Pipe Cleaner

2 Wiggle Eyes

5/8-inch Purple Ribbon

5 Assorted Colored
Plastic Jewels

White Household or
Craft Glue

Battery Operated Candle

Additional craft supplies to have on hand: Scissors, pencil, paper towels and newspaper.

Step 1, Getting Started: Read complete Black Cat Jar instructions before starting. Assemble all supplies.

Step 2, Assembling Black Cat Jar Base: Draw eyes for cat onto masking tape, making them about 1-inch wide. Turn jar upside down and affix tape to side of the jar, approximately 2-inches down from bottom of jar. Paint jar with black paint. Set jar aside to dry. Create the ears by cutting black felt into 1½-inch triangles and pink felt into 1-inch triangles. To create nose and mouth, cut ½-inch wide heart and upside down “T” from pink felt. Next, create the collar by gluing purple ribbon around the band. Glue jewels to collar. Once painted jar is dry, remove masking tape. Glue wiggle eyes, felt nose and mouth, pipe cleaner whiskers and ears onto jar in the appropriate places.

Step 3, Finishing Touches: Glue battery operated candle to the inside of the lid. Adjust lid and band onto jar. Set jar on lid to display. When ready to illuminate, remove lid and band. Turn candle on and readjust lid and band. **Important Note:** Use only a battery operated candle for this project.
