

MUMMY JAR

Project Supplies You Will Need

1 Ball® Regular Mouth Quart Jar

One 3" Diameter Foam Ball

4 1/2 yards x 4" Wide Stretch Gauze

Two 15mm Wiggle Eyes

White Spray Paint*

2-3 Black Plastic Spiders

Craft Glue Dots*

*We used Styrofoam® Brand Foam; Design Master® Color Tool® Spray Color Flat White; and Glue Dots® Int'l. Craft Glue Dots®.

Additional craft supplies to have on hand: Scissors, cardboard box and newspaper.

Fun Project Idea:

After wrapping your mummy, lightly spot spray with antique white or darker paint to give an "aged" look. You can also use a pint jar to make a "baby" mummy.

Step 1, Getting Started: Read all instructions before starting. Assemble all supplies.

Step 2, Painting Jar: Lay cardboard box on its side over newspaper in a well-ventilated area. Set jar in the box. Spray jar with several light coats of white, letting paint dry between coats. Let jar dry.

Step 3, Wrapping Mummy: Use glue dots to attach foam ball inside jar rim. Starting at bottom of jar, use a glue dot to secure end of gauze to jar, wrap gauze around jar and foam ball. Note: Practice wrapping, trying different ways to give "personality" to your mummy. When finished wrapping, use a glue dot to secure end of wrap.

Step 4, Finishing Touches: Place a glue dot on the back of each wiggle eye and attach to face. Similarly attach spiders to mummy.
