Project Supplies You Will Need

1 Ball® Smooth Jar

1 Ball Regular Lid and Band

Stickers*, Little Boy Themed

One 8 1/2" x 11" Sheet White Cardstock

Spring from Ball Point Pen (or 10" length of thin wire coiled around a pencil)

Black Fine Point Permanent Marker or Computer and Printer

Craft Glue Dots

Gum Balls

*We used Little Boys Sticker Sheet from Sandy Lion Sticker Designs™.

Additional craft supplies to have on hand: Scissors, ruler and pencil.

Fun Project Idea:

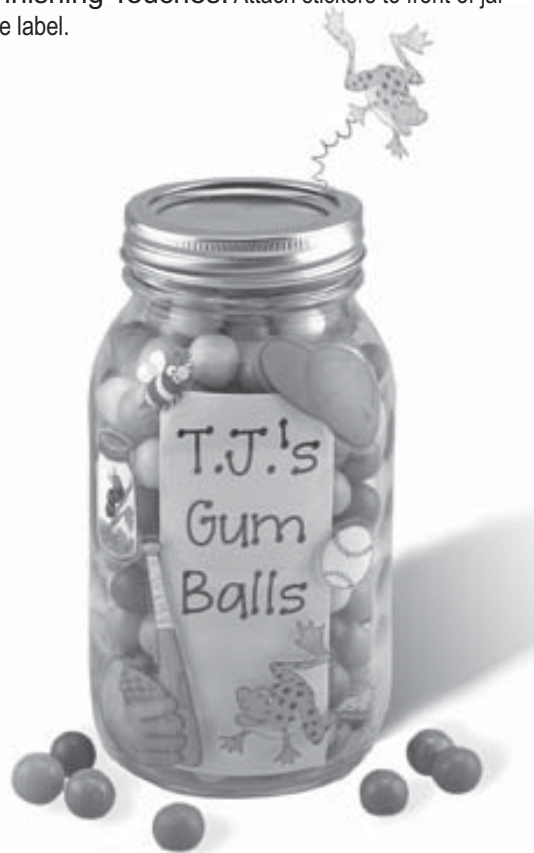
Other items that can be placed in the jar are marbles, baseball cards, small toys, matchbox cars or money. The label can be customized for whatever collection is placed in the jar. Or use this jar as fun wrapping for a small birthday gift!

Step 1, Getting Started: Read all instructions before starting. Assemble all supplies.

Step 2, Assembling Jar: For name label, use a computer and printer (or black marker) to print "child's name (or initials)" and "Gum Balls" on white cardstock. Trim cardstock to a vertical 2" x 4 1/2" piece. Place inside jar along front and fill jar with gum balls.

Step 3, Assembling Leap Frog: Attach frog sticker to white cardstock. Cut around frog sticker. Stretch out ball point pen spring and use a glue dot to attach one end to back of frog. Place jar lid onto jar and use glue dot to attach other end of spring to edge of lid. Twist jar band onto jar.

Step 4, Finishing Touches: Attach stickers to front of jar around name label.
