Project Supplies You Will Need

1 Ball® Wide Mouth Quart Jar

1 Ball® Wide Mouth Lid and Band

12"x12" Gingham Scrapbook Paper*

12"x12" Sponge Scrapbook Paper*

12"x12" Antiquity Green Parchment Flat Paper*

12"x12" Green Mesh Paper

Fall Leaves Vellum Die Cuts*

Nature Walk Fresh Cuts*

Brown Chalklets*

One 1" x 2" Lg. Rectangle Woodsies®*

1 1/2"x 2 1/2" Woodsies® tag*

Spanish Moss

Natural Colored Raffia

Craft Glue*

Twigs and other nature items

Fine line Permanent Black Marker

* We used Daisy D's scrapbook papers; K&Company Papers; DMD Industries, Inc. Vellum Leaves; EK Success Mini Fresh Cuts™ & Chalklets; Forster® Woodsies® and Tags, and Elmer's® Craft Bond™ Tacky Glue.

Additional craft supplies to have on hand: Scissors, ruler, pencil, makeup sponge, and paint brush.

Step 1, Getting Started: Read all instructions before starting. Assemble all supplies.

Step 2, Decorating Jar: Cut length of paper diagonally from Gingham scrapbook paper 4 1/2" x 13" to go around outside of jar. Tear along the long edges of the paper. Apply brown chalk with sponge along torn edges to give an "antique look." Wrap paper around jar, overlapping and gluing back. Tear randomly shaped pieces from scrapbook papers and sponge chalk on edges. Cut green mesh into various sized pieces. Layer and randomly glue paper and green mesh pieces onto Gingham paper. Use paint brush to apply extra glue to "decoupage".

Step 3, Accenting Jar: Glue to jar chosen twigs, Spanish moss and vellum leaf cuts, leaving edges unglued for dimension. Glue a Fresh Cut image to a Woodsies® large rectangle and glue to jar. Accent with Spanish moss and other items found in nature.

Step 4, Attaching Tag: Write "To" and "From" on Fresh Cut tag and personalize. Glue onto Woodsies® tag, string onto raffia and tie around neck of jar.

Step 5, Finishing Touches: Fill jar with matchsticks. Alternative: You may wish to fill jar using shells, stones, leaves or other items found on a vacation or a nature walk. Optional: To decorate jar lid place lid on back side of Gingham scrapbook paper. Trace around lid and cut on traced lines. Glue paper circle to top of jar lid. Then glue chosen nature items to lid. Place lid onto jar and twist on jar band.
