

PATRIOTIC CANDLE JAR

Project Supplies You Will Need

1 Ball® Regular Quart Jar

Red Votive Candle and Clear Glass Flower Pot Votive Holder

27 small (7/8") Woodsies® Stars*

Acrylic Paint*: True Blue, Primary Red, Shimmering Silver

Crystal Brush-on Glitter Paint*

Metallic Shreds, Generous handful each of: Blue, Red, and Silver

Paintbrush*

Craft Glue Dots

*We used Forster® Woodsies® Stars, DecoArt® Americana® Acrylic Paint, Dazzling Metallics® and Craft Twinkles® and Loew-Cornell® White Nylon, Series 797-F, Size 6 Flat Stain Paint Brush.

Additional craft supplies to have on hand: Scissors, newspapers, paper towels, paper plate and cup of water.

Fun Project Idea:

Use other colors of metallic or paper shreds to coordinate with other occasions or holidays. For an over-the-hill birthday party, as a table decoration, fill with black metallic shreds, silver stars and over the hill confetti.

Step 1, Getting Started: Read all instructions before starting. Assemble all supplies.

Step 2, Painting Stars: Paint both sides and edges of stars: 9 red, 9 blue, and 9 silver. Let dry. Brush crystal glitter on all stars and let dry.

Step 3, Filling Jar: Set aside a few shreds of each color and one red star for outside of jar. Pack red shreds into jar. Slip 4 blue and 5 silver stars into jar between shreds and jar alternating colors. Repeat with silver shreds, 4 blue and 4 red stars; and blue shreds with remaining red and silver stars.

Step 4, Finishing Touches: At neck of jar, use glue dots to attach metallic shreds and red star. Place votive holder and votive candle into top of jar.
