

PET BISCUIT JAR (CAT TREATS)

Project Supplies You Will Need

1 Ball® 12 oz. Quilted Crystal
Jelly Jar

1 Ball Regular Lid & Band

Jar Funnel

Jar Tamper

Recipe Card

Cookie Cutter

Mix For Jar

1 Cup Whole Wheat Flour

3/4 Cup Cornmeal

1 Tablespoon Dried Catnip

1 Cube Chicken Bouillon,
wrapped

To Prepare Treats, Add

1/4 Cup Boiling Water

1 Egg, beaten

1 Can (6 oz.) Tuna

Step 1, Getting Started: Read all instructions for the Cat Treats before starting. Assemble all supplies.

Step 2, Layering Dry Mix: Place Wheat Flour into the Jar and firmly pack using a Jar Tamper. Combine Cornmeal and Catnip in a small bowl. Layer mixture into the Jar, packing firmly and evenly. Place the Wrapped Bouillon Cube on top. Adjust Lid and Band. Makes base for one recipe of Cat Treats.

Step 3, To Prepare Cat Treats (*instructions to write on recipe card*): Preheat oven to 350 F. Remove Bouillon Cube from Jar and unwrap. Crush cube into small chunks and place into a small bowl. Add the boiling water, stirring to dissolve bouillon chunks. Set aside. Place remaining ingredients from the Jar into a large mixing bowl. Stir to combine. Add the bouillon broth, beaten egg and tuna. Stir to combine. Shape dough into small balls. Place balls on greased cookie sheet. Bake at 350 F for 15 minutes or until golden brown. Balls can be stored in an airtight container in the refrigerator for 3 weeks or in the freezer for up to 1 year in a freezer bag.

Step 4, Finishing Touches: Place a fabric round on top of the lid and hold in place with band. Adorn Jar with cat collar. Attach decorative recipe card with the "To Prepare" instructions on the Jar using raffia or ribbon. To complete the look, hang lattice balls or other cat toys from the collar.
