

STARRY NIGHT LUMINARY JAR

Project Supplies You Will Need

1 Ball® Wide Mouth
Quart Jar

1 Ball® Wide Mouth Band

1 (4-ounce) Can
Light Blue
Decorative Spray Stain

1 (4-ounce) Can
Metallic Silver
Spray Paint

1 (4-ounce) Clear Coat
Sealer Spray

Assorted Sizes Star,
Circle or Holiday Stickers

1 Yard Wire Edged
Holiday Ribbon

Sprigs of Holly
or Greenery

Glass Votive Holder

White Votive Candle

Additional craft supplies to have on hand: Scissors, rubber gloves, white household or craft glue, paper towels, cardboard box and newspapers.

Step 1, Getting Started: Read all instructions for Starry Night Luminary Jar before starting. Assemble all supplies.

Step 2, Assembling Starry Night Luminary Jar Base: Lay cardboard box on its side and newspaper down in a well-ventilated area. Put on rubber gloves. Spray light blue paint onto jar. Allow to dry. Place stickers randomly all over jar. Spray silver paint onto jar and band separately. Allow to dry, repeat if necessary for an even coating. Peel off stickers. Adjust band onto jar.

Step 3, Finishing Touches: Place glass votive holder on top of the jar opening and insert votive candle. For a softer glow, place candle inside jar. Tie ribbon around band and trim to desired length. Attach sprigs of holly or greenery and secure with glue.

Important Note: Use caution when using candles around children and never leave a lit candle unattended. A battery operated candle is a safe substitution.
